Key terminology

Daily supply charge	Charge that applies for supplying electricity to your premises for each day of the billing period, regardless of how much electricity you use.
kWh	'kWh' stands for kilowatt hour and is the unit of measurement for your electricity usage charges.
Feed-in tariff	Feed-in tariff is a cents per kWh rate paid for electricity fed back into the electricity grid by a solar PV system.
KW	Demand is measured in kilowatts (kW) and is the maximum rate of electricity consumption over a 30 minute billing interval.

Discounts

Discounts	Discounts apply to the GST exclusive usage charges only (off our published Origin Supply usage charges, which can be found on our website), and are only available to customers signing up to this offer from the above effective date.
Guaranteed Discount	A 22% discount on the GST exclusive usage charges listed above will apply for the benefit period.

Flexible Pricing Information	By choosing this tariff you may not be able to revert to your original tariff, but there will be a flat rate tariff available to you, except in some circumstances, which may include where you have a solar PV system. Eligibility	The offer set out in this Energy Price Fact Sheet is only available to customers in the relevant distribution area with the necessary metering system/configuration. To be eligible for this offer your solar PV system must be net metered and must not be larger than 10kW, and you must not be receiving a feed-in tariff under any Government scheme. If you remove your solar PV system from the supply address during the benefit period the offer will continue but you won't receive the feed-in tariff.
Small Demand Tariff Information	You must opt-in to a demand based network tariff and have a remotely read digital meter at your premises. After opting into this tariff you may be able to opt out however you may not be able to revert to your original tariff. There will be a flat rate tariff available to you, except in some circumstances. The reversion period ends 31 December 2020.
Cooling off period	10 business days. You may cancel this contract at any time within the cooling off period.

Solar feed-in tariffs	The feed-in tariff component of this offer commences once the solar meter has been connected to the grid. During the benefit period you'll receive a total feed-in tariff of 16 cents per kWh for every kWh of electricity exported to the grid. The 16 cents per kWh is made up of our standard retailer feed-in tariff of 9.9 cents per kWh and an additional feed-in tariff of 6.1 cents per kWh. The 'Terms and Conditions for Feed-in Tariffs – Victoria' applies to both the additional feed-in tariff and standard retailer tariff. When the benefit period ends you'll receive our standard retailer feed-in tariff available at the time your benefit period ends as published on our website. All amounts are GST-inclusive (if any).
